MANAGEMENT OF PERORBITAL GROWTHS

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The growths on periorbital area which is the thinnest part of skin are cosmetically and anatomically important. They are also significant from diagnostic and therapeutic applications. The best physicians who can accurately diagnose such conditions are the dermatologist and because of the technical knowhow are placed much better in managing majority of the lesions. The role of the other surgeons is equally important when it involves deeper structures.

Common growths that involves this areas are Syringomas, Hydrocystomas, Xanthelasmas, Hemangiomas, Keratoacanthomas, Skin malignancies, Dermoid Cysts and teratomas and minor conditions like Molluscum Contagiosum, Seborrhoeic Keratosis (DPN), Verrucae etc. Dermatologist should play a major role in managing majority of the periorbital growths. Their armamentarium like Radio surgery, Electrocautery, Chemical peels, Cryotherapy, Ultrapulse CO2 lasers, other lasers, Moh's surgery, etc are very useful in treating such growths without any major complications.
